## Details of Bursary

Since Dr. Wallace C. Abbott helped pioneer the new science of pharmaceutical medicine more than 100 years ago, Abbott continues its legacy of innovation that significantly improves the practice of health care.

## How to Enter

Complete the entry form overleaf. You may submit up to three entries per Gastroenterology Department. Provide a typed submission of no more than one side of an A4 page for each entry. Please provide three copies of your submission and entry form for distribution to the adjudication panel. Please supply relevant supporting materials (if appropriate) to aid your entry.

## Entry Criteria\*

Each typed submission should include the following headings:

### Hospital

### Lead consultant(s)

### Contact name

Include two names and contact details that the judges may contact should they have any queries relating to the entry.

### Introduction

A 15 word descriptive statement of project.

### Objectives

Clearly defined objectives with tangible targets and expected outcomes.

### Implementation and Tactic Strategy

All entries should pay special attention to innovation in the field and partnership initiatives.

### Outcomes

Outcome versus objectives and evaluation: please provide the evidence of the relationship between outcomes and the stated objectives and how this relationship was evaluated.

### Support Materials

Support materials may include booklets, posters, videos, audio tapes, CD ROMs, audit packs etc.
